I release all such persons from liability for any damage that may result from furnishing such evaluation to Camp Chamisall. I also grant permission for Camp Chamisall to perform a Criminal Records Check if required to update our records, for purposes of my protection against any false allegations and for the protection of those I serve. I consent to such investigation with the understanding that the results will be kept in extreme confidentiality by the leaders of Camp Chamisall and the Christian & Missionary Alliance (C&MA), in conformity with Camp Chamisall's guidelines for disclosure. I further agree to adhere to the child protection guidelines of the C&MA "Plan to Protect" as adopted by Camp Chamisall.

I have no objection to appearing in promotional media without compensation or any obligation to me.

I understand that if my character or morals should be deemed inappropriate, and/or criminal at any time during my volunteer service, that Camp Chamisall may terminate my involvement without expressed cause or prior notice. This could occur regardless of any oral, written or implied statements by Camp Chamisall persons prior to, at, or following the date of my volunteer service.

I understand that Camp Chamisall is responsible for the welfare of any person or persons entrusted to my care, and thus I will co-operate fully with the staff in the fulfillment of my duties. I will keep all personal information that I encounter in my role as a volunteer, strictly confidential. If at any time I find that for any reason I am unable to support the policies and procedures of Camp Chamisall, or the doctrine of the C&MA, (See page 3 C&MA Statement of Faith), or if my supervisors find that I am in conflict or disagreement with the policies, procedures or doctrine, I will quietly and gracefully resign my volunteer position.

THE CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. There is one God, who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
2. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He died upon the cross, the just for the unjust, as a substitutionary sacrifice, and all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood. He arose from the dead according to the Scriptures. He is now at the right hand of the Majesty on high as our great High Priest. He will come again to establish His Kingdom of righteousness and peace.
3. The Holy Spirit is a divine Person, sent to indwell, guide, teach, and empower the believer, and to convince the world of sin, of righteousness and of judgment.
4. The Old and New Testaments, inerrant as originally given, were inspired by God and are a complete revelation of His will for the salvation of people. They constitute the divine and only rule of Christian faith and practice.
5. Humankind, originally created in the image and likeness of God, fell through disobedience, incurring thereby both physical, and spiritual death. All people are born with a sinful nature, are separated from the love of God, and can be saved only through the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ. The destiny of the impenitent is existence forever in conscious torment, but that of the believer is everlasting joy and bliss.
6. Salvation has been provided only through Jesus Christ. Those who repent and believe in Him are united with Christ through the Holy Spirit and are thereby regenerated (born again), justified, sanctified and granted the gift of eternal life as adopted children of God.
7. It is the will of God that in union with Christ, each believer should be sanctified thoroughly thereby being separated from sin and the world and fully dedicated to God, receiving power for Holy living and sacrificial and effective service toward the completion of Christ's commission. This is accomplished through being filled with the Holy Spirit which is both a distinct event and a progressive experience in the life of the believer.
8. Provision is made in the redemptive work of Christ for the healing of the mortal body. Prayer for the sick and anointing with oil as taught in the scriptures are privileges for the church in this present age.

The universal church, of which Christ is the head, consists of all those who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, are redeemed through His blood, regenerated by the Holy Spirit, and commissioned by Christ to go into all the world as a witness, preaching the gospel to all nations. The local church, the visible expression of the universal church, is a body of believers in Christ who are joined together to worship God, to observe the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper, to pray, to be edified through the Word of God, to fellowship, and to testify in word and deed to the good news of salvation both locally and globally. The local church enters into relationships with other like-minded churches for accountability, encouragement and mission.
10. There shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and of the unjust; for the former a resurrection unto life; for the latter a resurrection unto judgment.
11. The second coming of the Lord Jesus is imminent and will be personal and visible. As the believers blessed hope, this vital truth is an incentive for Holy Living and sacrificial service toward the completion of Christ's commission.
